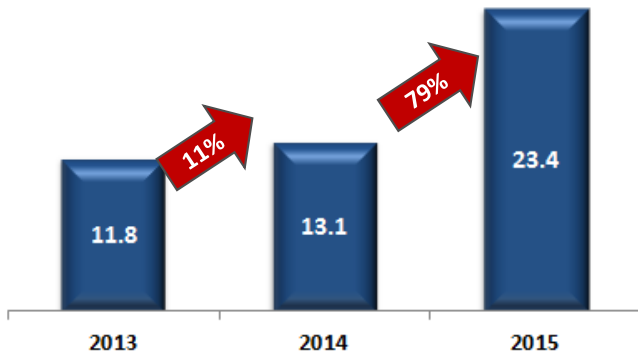

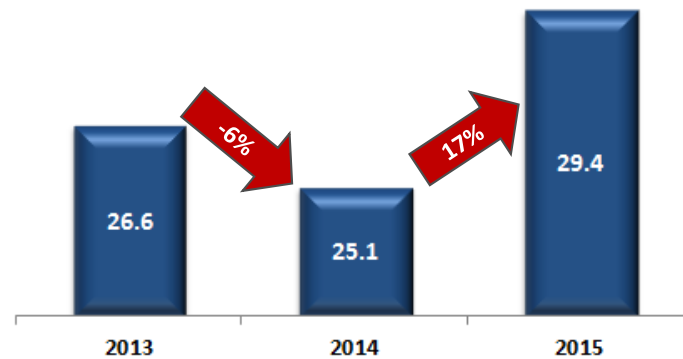

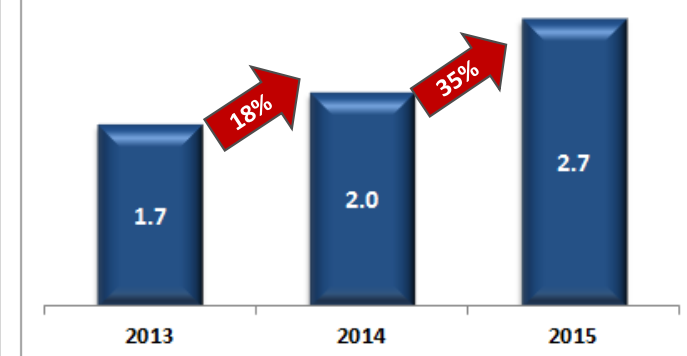
Net Sales (billion TL)



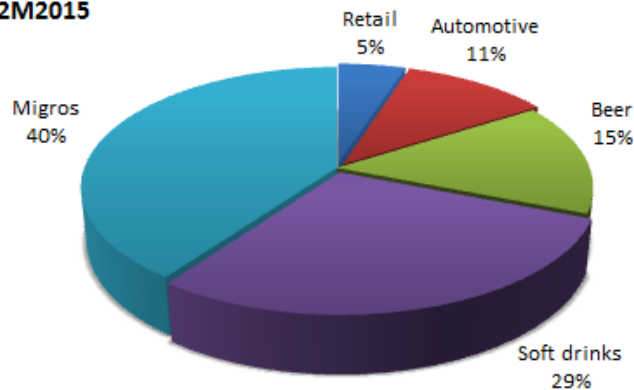
Asset Size (billion TL)



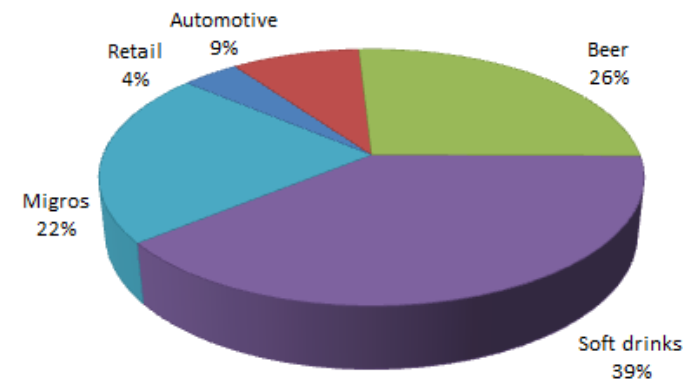
EBITDA (billion TL)

Breakdown of EBITDA, 12M2015

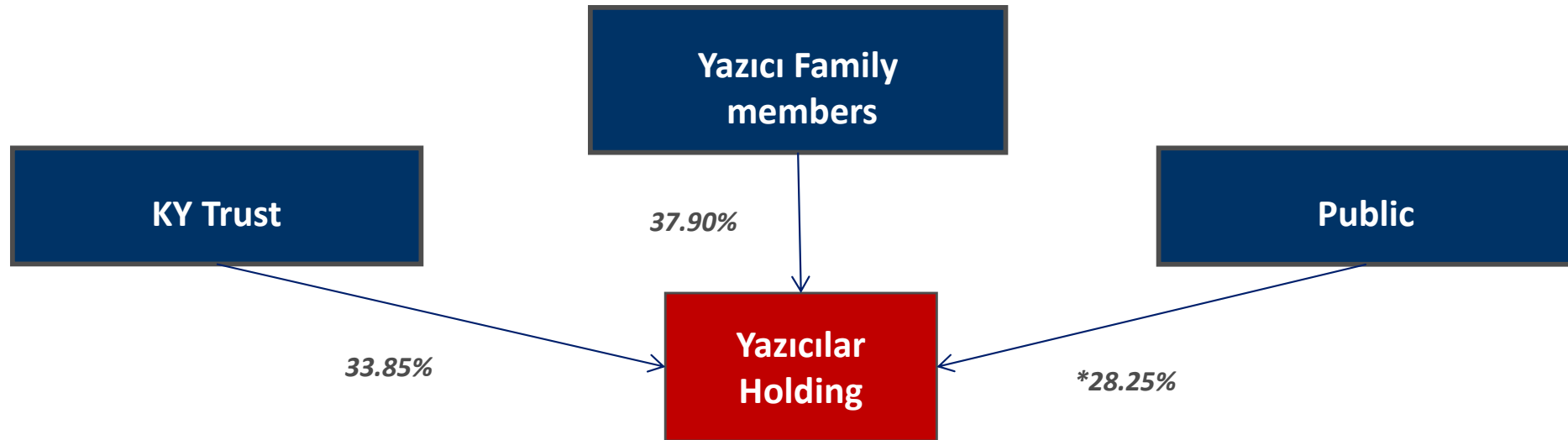

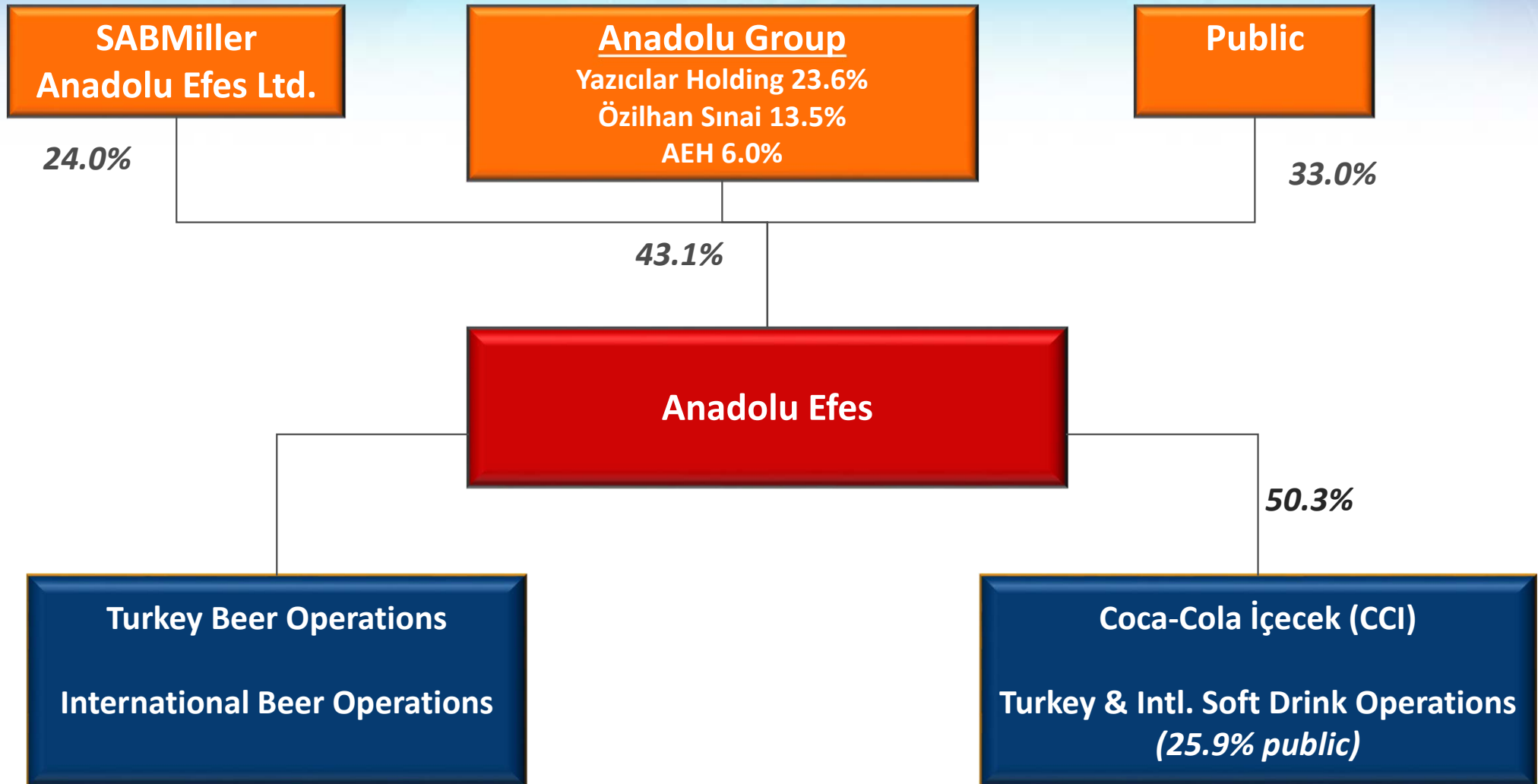


The Trust Company is managed by a Council of six members, five of which are non-family and chosen among prominent figures of the Turkish business community.

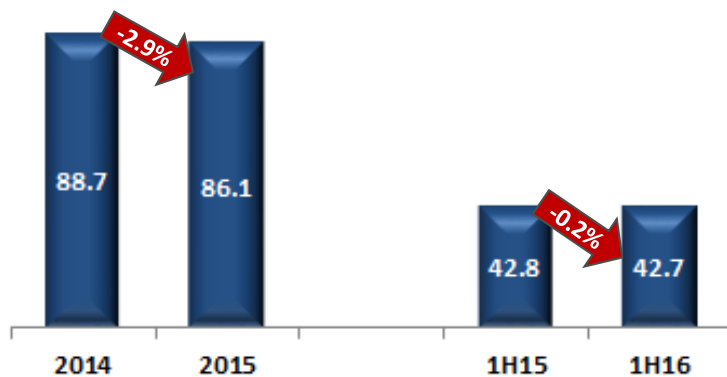

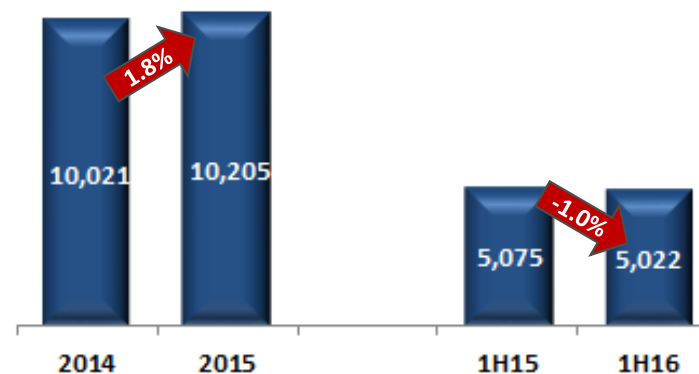




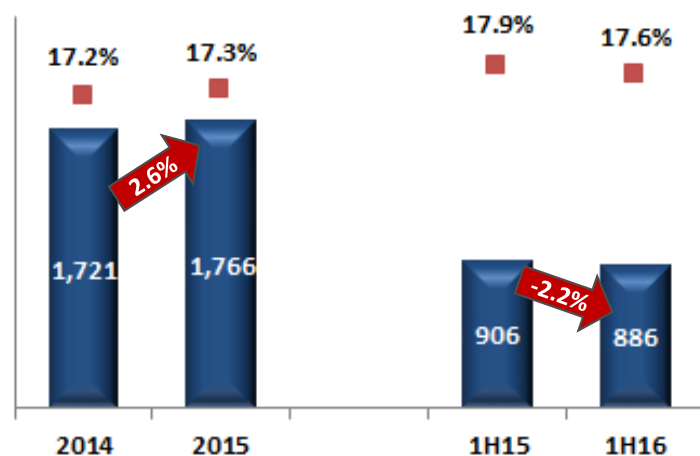
Sales volume - mhl



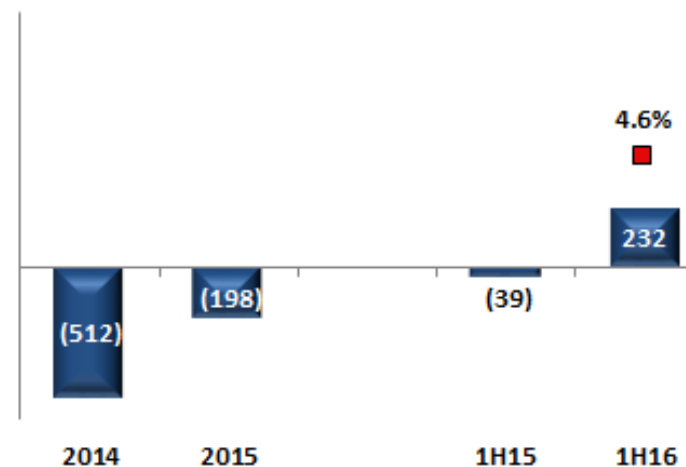
Net sales - million TL

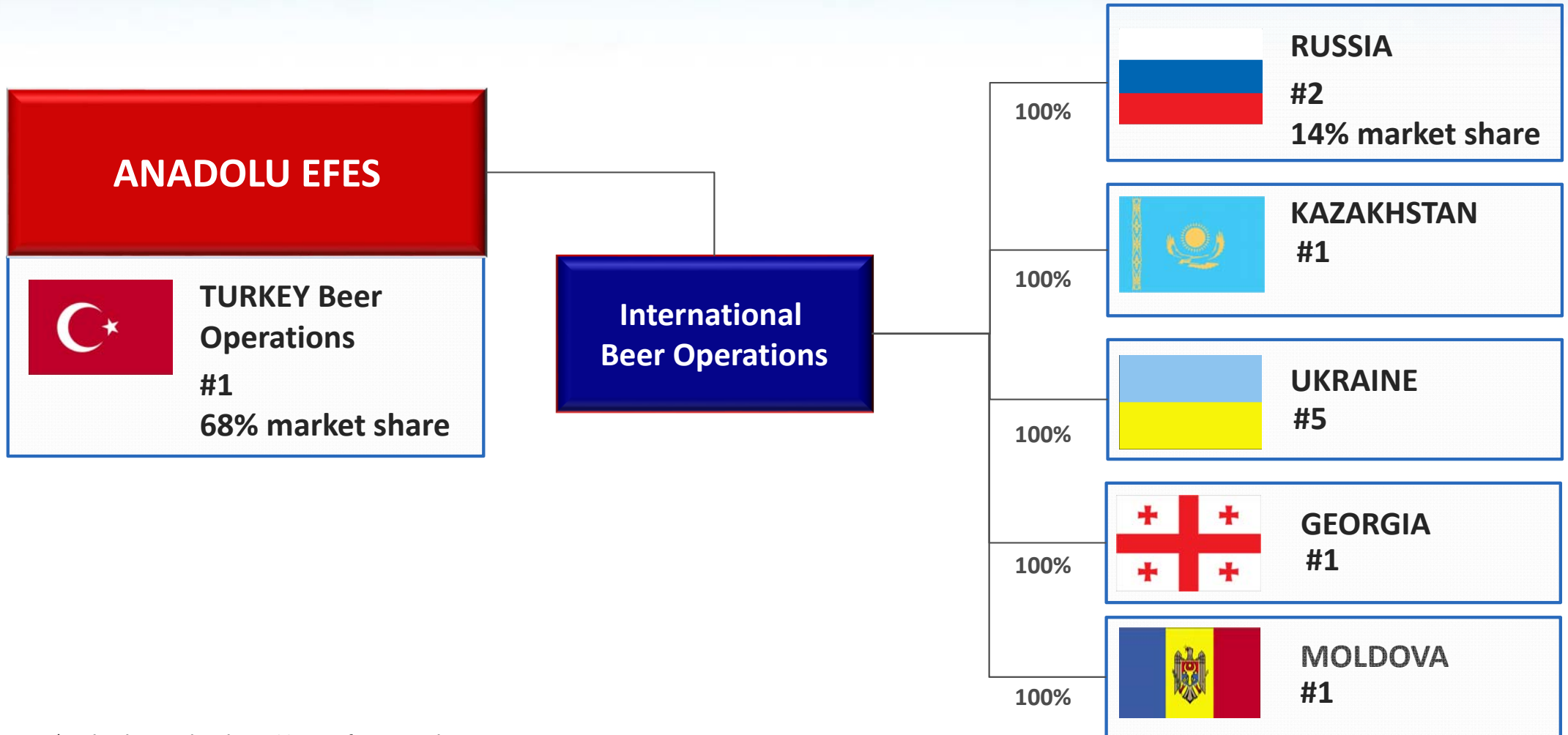


EBITDA (million TL) and EBITDA margin

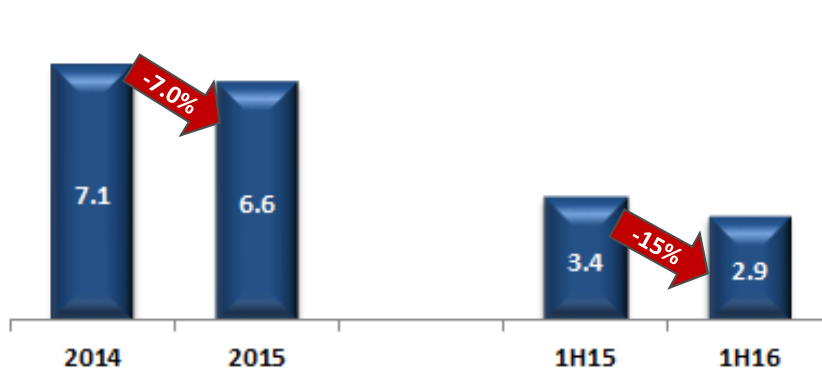

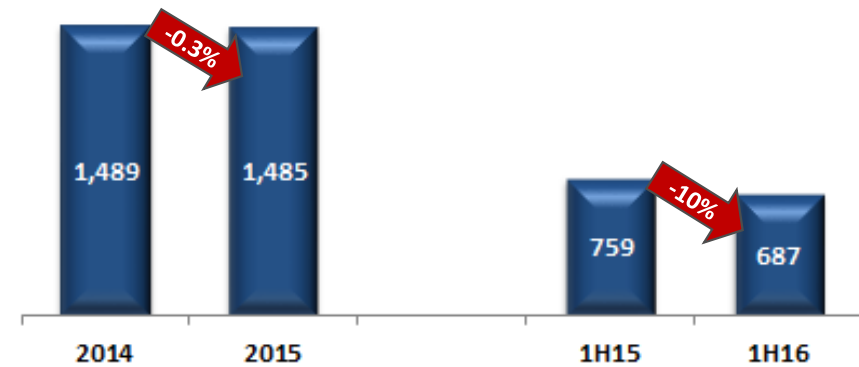

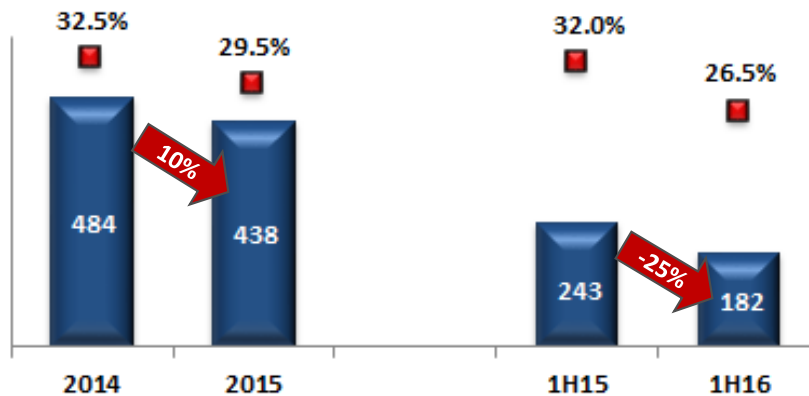
Sales volume - mhl



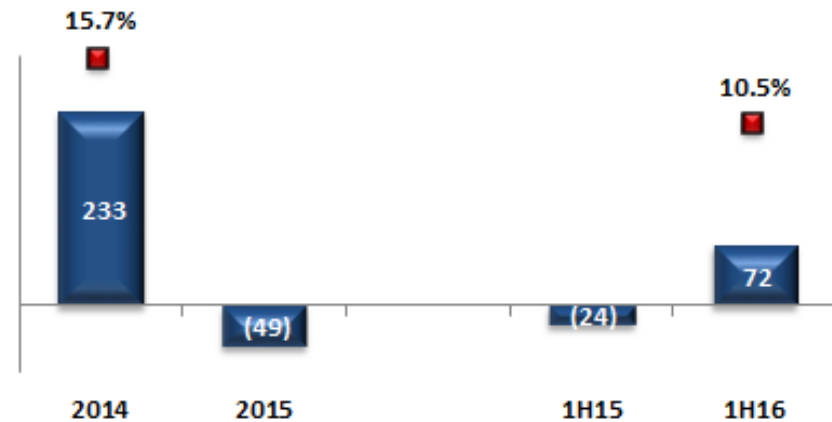
Net sales - million TL



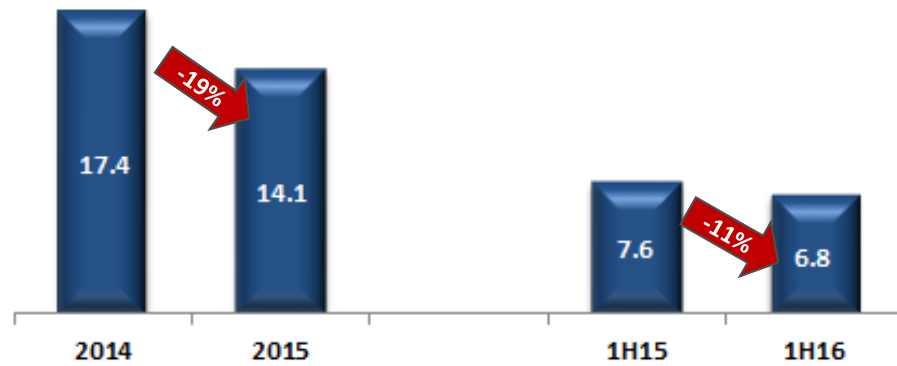
EBITDA (million TL) and EBITDA margin



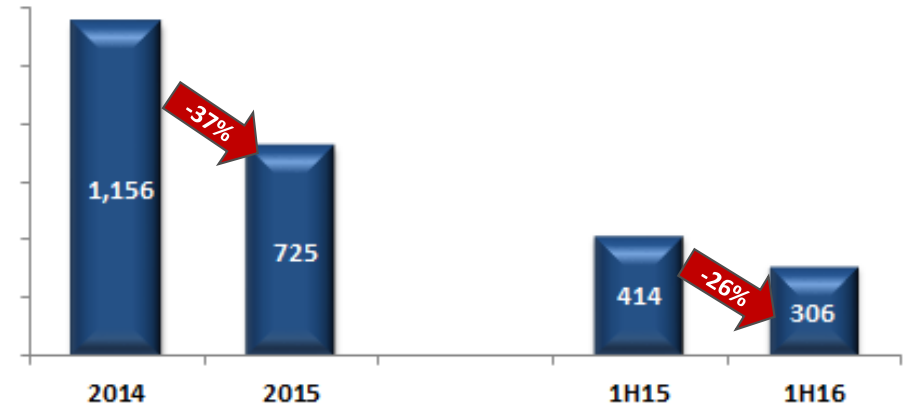
Net profit (million TL) and net profit margin



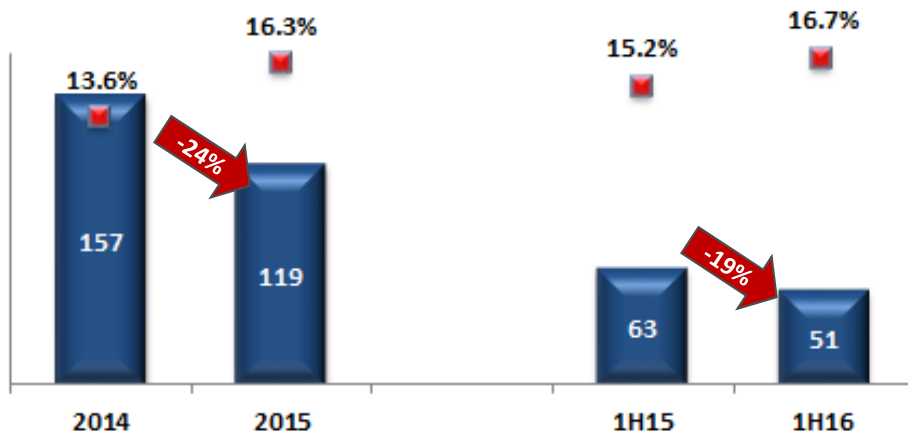

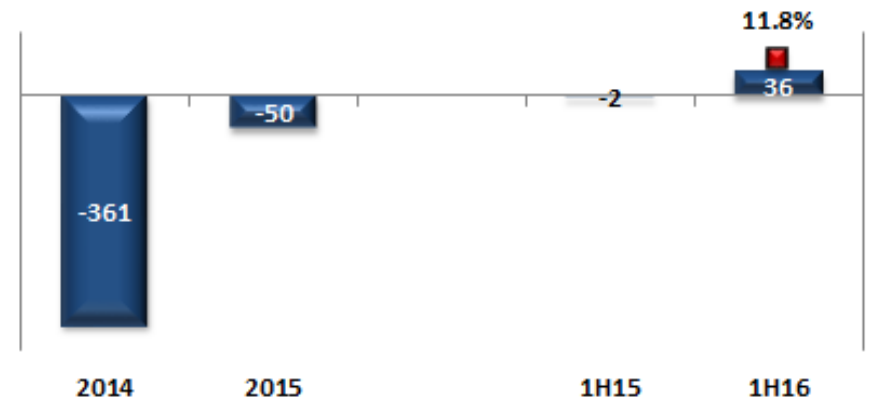
Net sales - USD mn

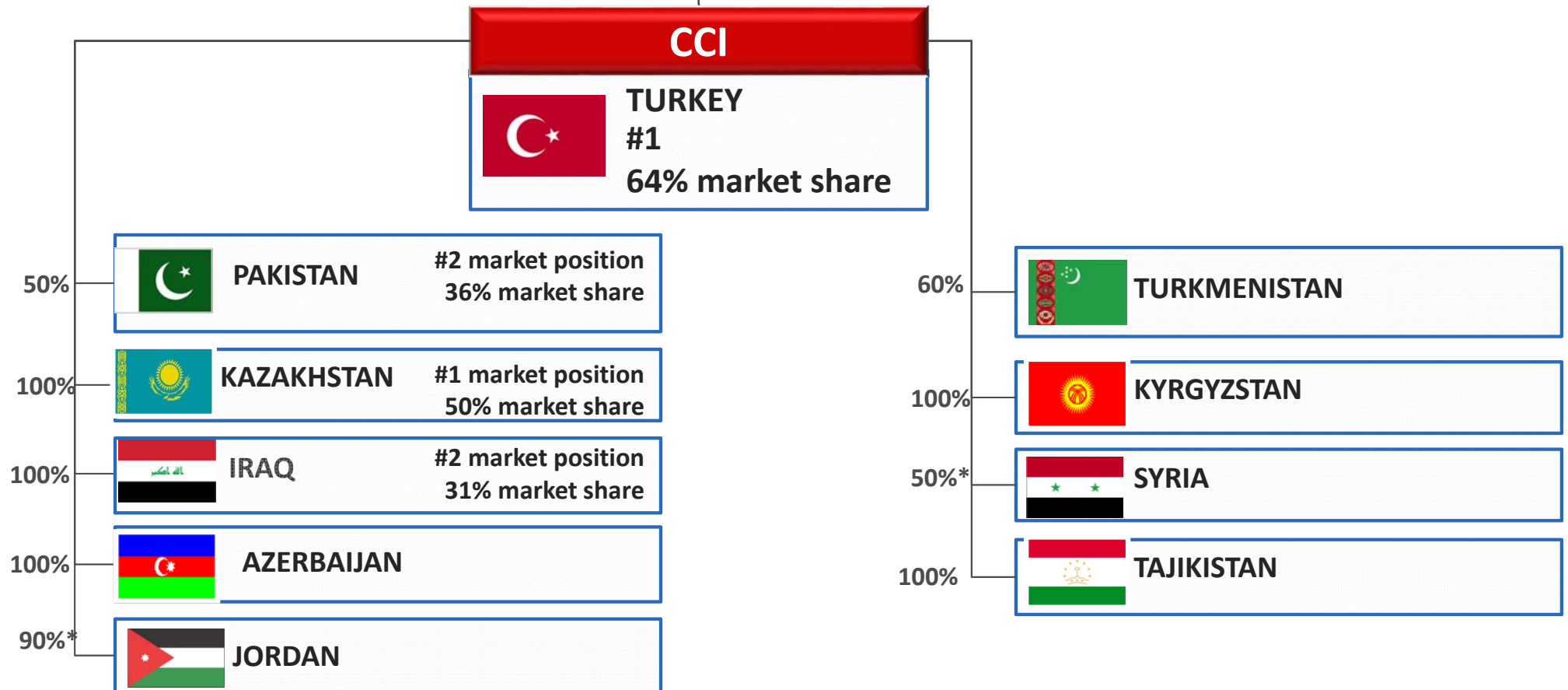


EBITDA (USD mn) and EBITDA margin
